\$2,000 awarded to a high school senior who is a resident of the Metro West Fire Protection District.



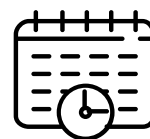
Eligibility

2023 Scholarship Information

Metro West Firefighters Community Outreach is a nonprofit organization funded by the employees of the Metro West Fire Protection District. These funds allow us to support the community we serve beyond the emergency calls for which we respond daily.

As such, Metro West Firefighters Community Outreach offers an annual scholarship in the amount of \$2,000 to a high school senior who is a **resident of the Metro West Fire Protection District**. The scholarship is to be used for higher education at an accredited college, university or technical trade school.

Eligibility requirements:

1. Must be a high school senior accepted to an accredited school of higher learning.
2. **Must be a resident of the Metro West Fire Protection District.**
 - Dependents, children and grandchildren of Metro West employees and retirees are ineligible.

Submission requirements:

1. Submit a completed application.
2. Submit a letter of acceptance or acceptance email from a college, university or technical training school.
3. Submit a written essay.
 - Information and requirements on page three.

Deadline:

1. Deadline for submission is **April 21, 2023**.
